8	Q.	Please state your name and business address.
9	A.	Matthew J. Barnes, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri, 65102.
10	Q.	By whom are you employed and in what capacity?
11	А.	I am employed by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission")
12	as a Utility R	egulatory Auditor IV.
13	Q.	Are you the same Matthew J. Barnes who sponsored Direct Testimony on
14	June 22, 201	8, and Rebuttal Testimony on July 20, 2018?
15	A.	Yes.
16	Q.	What is the purpose of your Surrebuttal Testimony?
17	А.	The purpose of my Surrebuttal Testimony is to respond to Silverleaf Resorts,
18	Inc. ("Silver	leaf") witness William G. Stannard's refiled Rebuttal Testimony regarding
19	portions of S	Staff's rate design proposal. I also briefly address the update to Staff's rate
20	design.	
21	Response to	Silverleaf's Witness Mr. Stannard
22	Q.	What is Mr. Stannard's major criticism of Staff's proposed rate design for
23	Silverleaf?

Q.

A. Mr. Stannard's major criticism of Staff's proposed rate design for Silverleaf is
 that Staff shifts too many dollars to the customer charge.

Are Silverleaf's water users typical permanent residential customers?

4 A. No. Staff considers Silverleaf's water users to be unique in that a majority of 5 Silverleaf's properties do not house permanent residents. Rather, Silverleaf's properties 6 consist of timeshare and condominium owners who rent these units to thousands of their customers each year. There are times that these units are not occupied, generally in the 7 off-season such as late fall through the winter; therefore, a unit will have little to zero usage 8 9 for that particular month. At times when there is little to zero usage, an operator must still 10 maintain the system so water is readily available to meet peak demands. The costs to 11 maintain the system from zero usage to peak demand is generally a fixed cost. This is one 12 reason Staff shifted more dollars to the fixed charge. Further, in order to create a reasonable 13 balance between fixed and variable charges, Staff allocated the cost of service to minimize the rate impact on customers and concluded that a fixed charge of \$26.73<sup>1</sup> and a commodity 14 15 charge of \$6.75 would be just and reasonable and allow Liberty the opportunity to recover its 16 cost of service.

Q. Do you have an example?

A. Yes. Mr. Stannard uses data from 2017 to conduct a bill frequency analysis.
Of the roughly 7,000 monthly bills, two accountholders account for over 3,000 of those
monthly bills. Of those two accountholders, 1,300 monthly bills have zero usage. However,
those same two accountholders also have the highest (2,100) monthly bills as well.

- What does that above information show?

2 Α. This information shows that these accountholders put a tremendous strain on 3 the system. To ensure that the system is capable of producing sufficient usage during peak 4 usage, the system has to be built to meet peak demand. Thus, the accountholders who are 5 causing the highest stress on the system should be the ones paying for that system. Thus, 6 even if a substantial amount of the accountholders monthly bills are for zero usage, the system has to be built to support the one or two months when usage is maxed. This means that the 7 fixed costs for having a properly sized system should be collected from those customers every 8 9 month through the customer charge.

Q. What is Mr. Stannard's proposed alternative rate design?

Mr. Stannard proposes an "across the board"<sup>2</sup> increase of 76.1% for water and 11 A. 12 70.7% for sewer for all of Silverleaf's meter sizes. While Staff does not generally disagree 13 with this approach, his commodity charge is \$10.50 and \$29.43 per 1,000 gallons of usage for 14 water and sewer respectively. If the Commission accepts Mr. Stannard's proposal, the customer charge would be on average for the state. However, the commodity charge for water 15 would be the second highest for the state and the commodity charge for sewer would be the 16 highest under PSC regulation. See Schedule MJB-s1 for a list of PSC regulated water and 17 18 sewer utilities ranked by commodity charge and customer charge.

Q. Mr. Stannard claims that low usage customers suffer the most with Staff's 20 proposed rate design. What is your response?

- 21 A. Using Staff's rate design proposal, a low usage customer's bill is not much 22 different compared to Mr. Stannard's proposed alternative rate design. Based on water usage

of 2,000 gallons per month, a customer's monthly bill would be \$3.56 higher under Staff's
 rate design proposal than Mr. Stannard's proposed alternative rate design. For sewer
 customers, based on water usage of 2,000 gallons per month, a customer's bill would be
 68 cents less under Staff's rate design proposal than Mr. Stannard's proposed alternative rate
 design proposal. See Tables 1 and 2 below.

Q. Can you provide a bill comparison based on different customer usage that
shows the impact of Staff's rate design proposal versus Mr. Stannard's alternative rate design
proposal?

9 A. Yes. Tables 1 and 2 below show the bill comparison of Staff's proposal
10 compared to Mr. Stannard's alternative proposal based on different customer usage for water
11 and sewer.

1 By shifting more dollars to the commodity charge as Mr. Stannard proposes, the more 2 water a customer uses the higher the bill will be versus Staff's proposal. Mr. Stannard's 3 proposal breaks from typical factoring by meter size and instead applies an across the board 4 percentage multiplier. While there is no absolute correct answer when considering rate 5 design, Staff is concerned that Mr. Stannard's proposal shifts significant amounts of cost 6 recovery away from the largest 3-inch meter customers and a greater percentage onto the 7 1-inch and 2-inch meter customers. Staff's rate design is reasonable as it properly allocates 8 the fixed and variable charges that minimize the impact on customer bills while allowing 9 Liberty the opportunity to recover its cost of service.

Q.

What would be the difference for the larger meter sized customers?

A. Table 3 shows the difference for the larger meter sized customers, based on
Staff's proposed rate design and compared to Mr. Stannard's proposed rate design.

Q. On page 25 in his refiled Rebuttal Testimony, Mr. Stannard presents Table 13
that shows fixed charge comparisons with different water and sewer companies in the state.
What is your response?

A. Mr. Stannard uses six (6) water companies in Missouri to compare their fixed
charge to Silverleaf's fixed charge. Five (5) of his example water companies are

municipalities. Municipal rates are usually not comparable to the rates of privately owned 1 2 systems due to the significant economic advantages associated with a publicly owned system. 3 In addition to being not-for-profit, municipalities have access to grants, federally subsidized loans, and have the ability to use additional funds from other sources within the municipality 4 5 to keep rates low. Table 4 below shows a sample comparison of Staff's proposed customer 6 charge for Silverleaf compared to other similar water companies that are regulated by the 7 Commission. Schedule MJB-s1 shows all of the water and sewer utilities regulated by the 8 Commission ranked by commodity charge and customer charge.
