ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR LEAVE TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

On January 12, 2021, Spire Missouri, Inc., d/b/a Spire, filed an application with the Commission seeking a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage a natural gas distribution system to provide gas service in Barry County, Missouri, as a further expansion of its existing certificated area (Application).

On February 15, 2021, Spire filed a separate application with the Commission seeking a CCN to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage a natural gas distribution system to provide gas service in Buchanan County, Missouri, as a further expansion of its existing certificated area. That application was assigned File No. GA-2021-0259.

In GA-2021-0259, Spire and the Staff of the Commission filed a stipulation and agreement and, subsequently, an amended stipulation and agreement (“Amended Agreement”). The Amended Agreement included a provision that Spire would withdraw

its application in GA-2021-0216, while reserving the right to refile its application at a later date. On November 12, 2021, the Commission issued an order in GA-2021-0259 approving the Amended Agreement and granting a CCN, with an effective date of December 12, 2021.

On January 3, 2022, Spire filed *Spire Missouri Inc.'s Motion for Leave to Withdraw Its Application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* in the case at hand requesting leave to withdraw its Application, with the ability to refile a similar application at a later date.

The Commission will grant Spire's motion and close this case.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Spire's motion for leave to withdraw its application for a CCN is granted.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
3. This file shall be closed on January 7, 2022.
