ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF STAFF REPORT

On July 2, 2013¹, Liberty filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission under Sections 393.1009, 393.1012 and 393.1015, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2012, requesting that the Commission authorize the company to establish an Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge for numerous gas utility plant projects. The Commission issued notice of the application on July 8, giving potential intervenors until July 29 to request intervention. The Commission received no intervention requests.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.265(11) states that the Staff of the Commission may examine the ISRS filing and file a report on its examination no later than 60 days after the filing. The Commission will order Staff to file its report as contemplated by the above-cited rule.


THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file its report concerning the above-referenced Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge no later than September 3, 2013.
