**ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING AND REQUEST
FOR CLARIFICATION**

On November 12, 2015, the Commission issued its Report and Order. On November 30, Laclede Gas Company applied for rehearing and for clarification. Laclede Gas Company seeks clarification as to whether the Commission is taking the position that safety-related equipment, specifically telemetry equipment, must not be operable before it can be considered to be in a deteriorated condition for ISRS qualification under Section 393.1009(5)(a), RSMo (Cum.Supp. 2013). The Commission finds that no additional clarification is needed.

The Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if, “in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear.”¹ The Commission finds that the application failed to establish such a sufficient reason. Therefore, the Commission will deny the application for rehearing.
