ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF STAFF RECOMMENDATION

On February 8, 2013, Southern Union Company d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy (“MGE”) filed a petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (“ISRS”) rate schedule to recover ISRS-eligible costs. On April 9, 2013, the Commission’s Staff recommended that the amount MGE should be allowed to recover through its ISRS be decreased from \$1,741,862, to \$1,741,740. On April 15, 2013, MGE filed a *Notice of Agreement, Motion for Expedited Treatment and Response to Order Directing Filing*, in which MGE stated that it accepts Staff’s recommendations and rates. On that same date, MGE filed a new tariff sheet with tariff tracking no. YG-2013-0450 and an effective date of May 15, 2013, in order to comply with Staff’s recommendation. The Commission will require Staff to provide a recommendation regarding the tariff sheet.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff shall file a recommendation regarding the new tariff sheet, tariff tracking no. YG-2013-0450, no later than April 24, 2013.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
