ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND

On December 6, 2013, Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Laclede Gas Company (“MGE”) filed an application and petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting that the Commission authorize it to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (“ISRS”). The Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion on December 18 asking the Commission to reject that application.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13) allows the other parties ten days in which to respond to a motion unless a different time for response is established by the Commission. That means responses to Public Counsel’s motion would be due on December 28. On December 27, the Commission’s Staff and MGE filed a joint motion asking to be allowed until January 3, 2014, to respond.

The Commission finds the request for more time to respond to be reasonable and will grant that request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Joint Motion for Extension of Time is granted
2. Any party wishing to respond to the Office of the Public Counsel’s Motion to

Reject Application shall do so no later than January 3, 2014.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
