**ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE**

On August 18, 2015, USW Local 11-6 ("Local 11-6") filed an application to intervene in this matter. The Commission issued an order setting an August 24 deadline for objections to Local 11-6's application. No objections were received.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3) authorizes the Commission to grant an application to intervene if the party has an interest different from that of the general public which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would serve the public interest.

Local 11-6 is a labor organization that represents over 1000 of Laclede Gas Company's employees. Local 11-6 is concerned with the impact the requested Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge application will have on its members' jobs. Local 11-6's interest is different from those of the general public and may be impacted by a final order in this case. Local 11-6's participation may serve the public interest by providing the Commission with its perspective.

Upon review of the unopposed application, the Commission finds Local 11-6 meets the standards set in the Commission's rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3). Therefore, the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

In its application, Local 11-6 requested a waiver of Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(J) which requires an unincorporated association to list all of its members. The Commission will grant the requested waiver.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The application of USW Local 11-6 to intervene in this matter is granted. USW Local 11-6 will comply with the deadlines as set by the Commission's August 11 order establishing a procedural schedule.
2. USW Local 11-6's is granted a waiver of the members identification requirement of Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(J).
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
