**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO
STAFF’S RECOMMENDATION**

On February 19, 2016, Liberty Utilities (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities (“Liberty”) filed a petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (“ISRS”) rate schedule to recover ISRS-eligible costs. On April 19, 2016, the Commission’s Staff recommended that the amount Liberty should be allowed to recover through its ISRS be decreased by \$416 from that requested to a total amount of \$208,789 for this case, in the amounts by district of WEMO (\$4,266), SEMO \$10,211, and NEMO \$202,844. The Commission will require Liberty and any other interested party to respond to Staff’s recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Liberty Utilities (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities shall respond to Staff’s recommendation no later than April 29, 2016.
2. Any other party wishing to respond or object to Staff’s recommendation shall do so no later than April 29, 2016.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
