ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO RESPOND

Staff and the respondents have filed competing proposed procedural schedules that the Commission will be considering at its agenda session on June 27. The chief difference in those proposed schedules is the amount of time allowed between Staff's filing of direct testimony and the filing of rebuttal testimony. Both proposed schedules call for direct testimony to be filed on October 24. Before considering those schedules, the Commission would like to know whether Staff would be able to file its direct testimony one week earlier, on October 17, 2006.

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a response before 9:00 a.m. on June 27, 2006, indicating whether it would be able to file its direct testimony on October 17, 2006.
2. This order shall become effective on June 27, 2006.
