NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT
AND CLOSING CASE

Issue Date: April 11, 2007

On November 17, 2006, R. J. Liebe Athletic Lettering Company filed a complaint with the Commission against Laclede Gas Company (“Laclede”). Laclede filed its answer on December 21, 2006, and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its report on January 22, 2007.

On April 9, 2007, prior to the filing of any testimony or the admission of any evidence, Complainant filed a Notice of Voluntary Dismissal stating that it “believes that refiling its complaint at a later time will be in its best interest by making a new complaint that is plainer and clearer, and by not engaging the commission’s time until complainant is able to marshal the resources to better present its claims.” Complainant also states that all parties of record had been served with a copy of the notice.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) permits a complainant to voluntarily dismiss its complaint without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered by filing a notice of dismissal and serving a copy on all parties. No prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered in this case, and Complainant represents that all parties have been served with its notice. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that R. J. Liebe Athletic Lettering Company has voluntarily dismissed its complaint. Nothing remains for decision by the Commission and this case may be closed.
