ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On December 6, 2006, Marlyn Young filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Laclede Gas Company. Complainant states that he has been overcharged for service and, due to loss of service, is requesting compensatory damages.
