NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT
AND CLOSING CASE

Issue Date: March 31, 2008

Ozark Energy Partners, LLC (“OEP”) filed a formal complaint against Southern Missouri Gas Company, L.P. d/b/a Southern Missouri Natural Gas (“SMNG”) on November 9, 2007. On March 27, 2008, prior to the filing of any prepared testimony or the submission of any oral evidence, OEP filed a Notice of Voluntary Dismissal (“Notice”), in which the company requested that the Commission acknowledge the Notice and dismiss the case with prejudice pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1), which permits a complainant to voluntarily dismiss a complaint without an order of the Commission “at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered, by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission and serving a copy on all parties.”

No prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered in this case, and the Notice has been filed with the Commission and served on all parties. Therefore, the

Commission acknowledges that OEP has voluntarily dismissed its complaint against SMNG with prejudice. Nothing remains for decision by the Commission and this case may be closed.¹
