On February 1, 2006, Kansas City Power & Light Company submitted to the Commission proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for electrical service provided in its Missouri service area. On February 3, the Commission ordered that anyone who wished to intervene in this case do so no later than February 23.

On August 1, W. Bill Dias, d/b/a 1.PayStation.com, asked to intervene out of time. To help the Commission evaluate Mr. Dias' application, the Commission will order Mr. Dias to produce the February 12, 2001 Memorandum of Understanding he refers to in his application. Because Mr. Dias' pleadings indicate that he plans on attending the local public hearing set for noon on August 24, Mr. Dias shall submit the Memorandum of Understanding at that hearing.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. W. Bill Dias shall submit the above-referenced Memorandum of Understanding at the local public hearing set for noon, August 24, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on August 22, 2006.
