ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

On February 1, 2006, Empire District Electric Company filed a tariff with the Missouri Public Service Commission. The Commission established February 27, 2006, as the deadline for interested parties to intervene. Kansas City Power & Light Company filed an application to intervene.
