The issues likely to be before the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") include the Company's fulfillment of the applicable application requirements pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-2.060, 20 CSR 4240-10.125, and the Commission's *Order Approving Application* effective March 19, 2022, in File No. EF-2022-0164, which established certain additional conditions in the Company's subsequent requests for financing authority. Ameren Missouri has not had any communication with the Office of the Commission (as defined in 20 CSR 4240-4.015(10)) within the last 90 days respecting the request in this new specific request.
