RESPONSE TO COMMISSION ORDER

COMES NOW Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede" or "Company"), and in Response to the Commission's Order Directing Filing in the above-captioned case, states as follows:

- 1. On June 26, 2002, Laclede filed an Application for Variance requesting a variance from certain Commission Rules in order to permit the Company to offer an electronic billing and payment option to its customers on economic terms.
- 2. On July 23, 2002, the Commission issued an Order Directing Filing in which it directed Laclede to file a response indicating (a) whether customers, upon choosing to participate in the electronic billing and payment program will be notified that disconnection notices will be sent electronically; and (b) how customers will be notified that disconnection notices will be sent electronically.
- 3. In response, Laclede represents that while the text on the current computer enrollment form advises customers that they will be receiving electronic rather than paper bills once they enroll in the program, it does not explicitly state that their first disconnection notice will also be sent electronically. Many customers may surmise this since Laclede has customarily used its paper bill mailings to send out the first disconnection notice, and the absence of the one would suggest the absence of the other.

Nevertheless, Laclede will modify the text on the computer enrollment form to specifically advise the customer that by enrolling in the program the customers will also be agreeing to receive his or her first disconnection notice electronically as part of the customer's electronic bill. When combined with the program's existing feature that requires the customer to acknowledge the "pop-up" disconnection notice before he or she can access the electronic bill and the fact that customers will continue to receive a second and third standard disconnection notice in accordance with Commission rules, such measures should provide adequate notification safeguards both before and after the customer enrolls in the program.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Laclede Gas Company respectfully requests that the Commission take notice of this Response.
