ORDER *NUNC PRO TUNC*

On June 11, 2020, the Commission issued two orders in Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire’s application requesting a temporary waiver of compliance with certain gas safety rules under 20 CSR 4240-40.030 and certain Commission orders. The orders are entitled *Order on Application for Temporary Waivers* and *Order Approving Application for Temporary Waiver and Directing Written Notice*.

On June 15, 2020, the Commission’s Staff filed a motion to correct typographical errors in some citations in the orders. Commission Staff also requests the Commission correct a sentence in a footnote to clarify Staff’s recommendation.

The Commission issues this *nunc pro tunc* order to correct these errors, which are not substantive. In addition, the Commission will direct notice of this order to the U.S. Secretary of Transportation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. In both orders, all citations to 20 CSR 4240-40.030(13)(M)1, 20 CSR 4240-40.030(13)(M)2.A and 20 CSR 4240-40.030(13)(M)2.B are corrected to provide the full citation, as stated here.

2. Footnote 3 of *Order Approving Application for Temporary Waiver and Directing Written Notice* is corrected to state in full: “Staff advises waiver of 20 CSR 4240-40.030(9)(Q)1 requires waiver of 49 C.F.R. 192.481(a) and waiver of 20 CSR 4240-40.030(13)(M)1, 20 CSR 4240-40.030(13)(M)2.A and 20 CSR 4240-40.030(13)(M)2.B require waiver of 49 C.F.R. 192.723(a) and (b)(1).”

3. By no later than 5 p.m. on June 17, 2020, the Commission’s data center shall provide written notice of this order to the U.S. Secretary of Transportation by attaching a copy of this order in an email message addressed to PHMSA.Pipelinesafety@dot.gov with “Notice to Secretary of Transportation – nunc pro tunc order” indicated in the subject line. The same message shall also include, as an attachment, a copy of the *Order Approving Application for Temporary Waiver and Directing Written Notice*, issued on June 11, 2020.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
