ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

On December 13, 2022, The Empire District Gas Company d/b/a Liberty (“EDG”) filed an application with the Commission seeking a variance of the requirement to implement a new Sample Meter Testing Plan. The Commission directed the Staff of the Commission (Staff) to file a recommendation with regard to the application or a request for an extension of time to do so.

Staff timely requested an extension of time to file its recommendation until April 25, 2023. Staff stated it needed additional time to continue its review, receive responses to outstanding data requests, and draft its recommendation. By Commission rule, ten days are allowed for parties to respond to any pleading.¹ No objections or responses were received.

The Commission finds the request reasonable and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff’s request for an extension is granted. Staff shall submit its recommendation, or a request for further extension, on or before April 25, 2023.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
