**ORDER CHANGING FILING DATES AND DIRECTING FILING**

Effective Date: August 13, 2007

On July 18, 2007, the Commission issued an order setting a filing date of August 20, 2007, for the Staff of the Commission to file its recommendation concerning Aquila, Inc.'s Quarterly Cost Adjustment Tariff No. YH-2008-0039, and a filing date of August 24, 2007, for any party to file a response to the Staff's recommendation. Aquila has withdrawn this tariff sheet; therefore, the Commission will cancel the filing dates concerning Tariff No. YH-1008-0039.

Aquila filed a new Quarterly Cost Adjustment tariff sheet (assigned Tariff No. YH-2008-0100) on August 8, 2007, for the quarter beginning September 1, 2007. The tariff sheet bears a 30-day effective date of September 7, 2007. On August 9, 2007, Aquila, filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment, requesting that the Commission approve the tariff to become effective on September 1, 2007, the first day of the quarter covered by the tariff. The Commission will direct its Staff to respond to the motion by filing either its recommendation or a status report indicating the earliest possible date by which it could file its recommendation. In addition, the Commission will set a time for any other objections to the Motion for Expedited Treatment.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The filing dates established for the Commission Staff's recommendation regarding Tariff No. YH-2008-0039, and for any responses to the recommendation, are canceled.
2. No later than August 20, 2007, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file either its recommendation regarding Tariff No. YH-2008-0100 or a status report indicating the earlier possible date on which it can file its recommendation.
3. Any other party wishing to file a response to the Motion for Expedited Treatment or to Tariff No. YH-2008-0100 shall do so no later than August 20, 2007.
4. This order shall become effective on August 13, 2007.
