RECOMMENDATION**

On January 20, 2012, the Commission's Staff filed a recommendation regarding KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's 2008 steam operations quarterly cost adjustment (QCA). Staff reports it has reviewed GMO's 2008 cost filings and concludes that there are no material differences in the QCA and actual fuel costs that would require a rate adjustment under the QCA process. For that reason, Staff recommends this case be closed with no further action.

Before acting on Staff's recommendation, the Commission will give other interested parties an opportunity to respond.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Staff's recommendation shall do so no later than February 6, 2012.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
