ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF STATUS REPORTS

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This case remains open pending receipt of the Commission Staff's true-up audit of the "fuel rider" for the period covered by the case. On August 18, 2008, Staff filed a status report. Staff stated that Ag Processing, Inc., and Aquila, Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks-L&P,¹ are continuing discussions and have made progress, but that they have not yet resolved all of their differences. Attention necessarily devoted to planning and executing the integration of Aquila's operations with those of Kansas City Power & Light Company, as authorized in Case No. EM-2007-0374,² has hampered progress in this case. Staff stated that until the scope and parameters for true-up audits of Aquila's steam "fuel rider" are determined, Staff is unable to indicate the date on which it expects to file its true-up audit of the fuel rider.

¹ Aquila recently merged with a subsidiary of Great Plains Energy Incorporated in Case No. EM-2007-0374. Following that merger, Aquila changed its fictitious name in Case No. EN-2009-0015, and is now doing business as KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company.

² In the Matter of the Joint Application of Great Plains Energy Incorporated, Kansas City Power & Light Company, and Aquila, Inc., for Approval of the Merger of Aquila, Inc., with a Subsidiary of Great Plains Energy Incorporated and for Other Related Relief, Report and Order issued July 1, 2008.

The Commission will establish a schedule for further status reports to be filed. This case is related to Case No. HR-2007-0028, Aquila's previous steam quarterly cost adjustment case. In that case, Staff has been directed to file status reports at three-month intervals until its true-up audit is complete. Staff's most recent report in HR-2007-0028 was filed on August 18, 2008; therefore, its next report will be due on or before November 30, 2008. The next report in this case shall also be due on November 30, 2008.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file further status reports in this case at three-month intervals until its true-up audit is completed. The next status report shall be due no later than November 30, 2008.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
