**ORDER CANCELING DISCOVERY CONFERENCE**

Effective Date: March 4, 2022

On February 17, 2022, all of the parties to the case – OMC, SNGMO, the Staff of the Commission (Staff), and the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) (collectively, “the Parties”) – filed a joint revised procedural schedule. That schedule proposed a Discovery Conference for March 7, 2022.

The schedule also stated that not less than three business days before each discovery conference, any party that has a discovery concern shall file a brief statement describing that concern. Finally, the schedule states that if no party identifies any discovery concerns before the scheduled conference, the presiding officer may cancel that conference.

No party has filed a statement identifying any discovery concerns and the scheduled discovery conference is less than two business days away. Thus, the discovery conference will be canceled.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The discovery conference proposed for March 7, 2022, is canceled.
2. This order is effective when issued.
