ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Issue Date: March 8, 2023 Effective Date: March 8, 2023

On December 19, 2022, Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire (Spire) filed its answer to the complaint in this matter, and on January 27, 2023, the Commission's Staff (Staff) filed its report concerning Structural Glass Systems, Inc.'s (SGS) complaint. Spire responded to Staff's report and recommendation on February 6, 2023. On March 2, Staff filed a joint proposed procedural schedule, signed by attorneys for Staff, Spire, and SGS.

As the parties unanimously agreed to the proposed schedule, the Commission will adopt it, but change the date the parties will file the stipulation of undisputed facts, and list of issues and order of witnesses to allow the Commission a full business day before the hearing to review it. The parties have also agreed to waive prefiled testimony and instead take testimony live at the evidentiary hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following procedural schedule is established:

April 7, 2023 Last Day to Request Discovery

May 4, 2023 Stipulation of Undisputed Facts

May 5, 2023 List of Issues, Order of Witnesses, and Order of Cross Examination

May 10, 2023 Evidentiary Hearing

June 7, 2023 Briefs

- 2. The Commission shall hold an evidentiary hearing on May 10, 2023, beginning at 9:00 a.m.
- 3. The hearing shall be held at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you need additional accommodations to participate in this hearing, please call the Public Service Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711 before the hearing.
 - 4. The parties shall comply with the following procedures:
 - (A) Although not all parties may agree upon how each issue should be described or on whether a listed issue is in fact a proper issue in this case, the parties shall agree upon and file a list of the issues to be heard, the witnesses to appear on each day of the hearing, the order in which they will be called, and the order of cross-examination for each witness. The list of issues should be detailed enough to inform the Commission of each issue that must be resolved. The Commission will view any issue not contained in this list of issues as not requiring resolution by the Commission.
 - (B) Each party shall file a simple and concise statement summarizing its position on each disputed issue.

- (C) All pleadings, briefs, and amendments shall be filed in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080. Briefs shall follow the same list of issues as filed in the case and must set forth and cite the proper portions of the record concerning the remaining unresolved issues that are to be decided by the Commission.
- (D) If testimony or documents are prefiled and served upon the parties before a hearing, a party need only provide an emailed copy of the testimony or document to exhibits@psc.mo.gov. If not prefiled and served upon the parties, then a party who has a document marked for use at the hearing shall email it to the presiding officer, and counsel for each other party, prior to the hearing if possible.
- (D) Each party shall prepare a list of its exhibits and submit a copy of that list to every other party and to the regulatory law judge no later than two business days prior to the evidentiary hearing. The lists shall also be filed in the EFIS case file. Exhibits that may be offered during cross-examination, but which have not been pre-filed, need not be included on the list. However, when those documents are offered during the hearing, they will be assigned a number from that party's number group.
- 5. Exhibit numbers are assigned as follows:

1-99 SGS 100-199 Spire 200-299 Staff 300-399 Office of the Public Counsel

Exhibits shall be marked as set forth in Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.135(10)(C). For example, the public version of exhibit two would be marked as Exhibit 2, whereas the confidential version of exhibit two would be marked as Exhibit 2C.
