- 1 PROCEEDINGS
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: We'll go on the record, then.
- 3 Good morning, everyone. Welcome to the prehearing
- 4 conference in Case No. GC-2006-0182. My name is Morris
- 5 Woodruff. I'm the Regulatory Law Judge assigned to this case.
- 6 Let's go ahead and take entries of appearance.
- 7 First of all, for the Staff?
- 8 MR. SCHWARZ: Tim Schwarz, Deputy General Counsel,
- 9 P. O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, appearing for
- 10 the Staff of the Commission.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you.
- 12 And for Southern Missouri Gas?
- 13 MR. FISCHER: Jim Fischer, Fischer & Dority, P.C.,
- 14 101 Madison Street, Suite 400, Jefferson City, Missouri 65101,
- 15 appearing on behalf of -- I guess it's actually Sendero
- 16 SMGC LP Acquisition Company.
- 17 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. And for Public Counsel?
- 18 MR. MILLS: Lewis Mills. My address is Post Office
- 19 Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, appearing on behalf
- 20 of the Public Counsel and the Public.
- 21 JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. And a few minutes ago
- 22 a notice of a dismissal was filed by Staff.
- 23 Mr. Schwarz, do you want to tell us what that was
- 24 about?
- 25 MR. SCHWARZ: Well, Staff has further investigated

- 1 the matter with Sendero, and is of the opinion that the
- 2 failure to retain a general manager in the appointed time was
- 3 excusable.
- 4 Staff believes that the most expeditious and
- 5 efficient way of -- of answering any Commission questions on
- 6 the matter would be if -- if the Commission could meet or deal
- 7 directly with the involved Staff members. And -- and we think
- 8 that by dismissing the complaint will give them the
- 9 opportunity to do so, if they're so inclined.
- 10 And, of course, the Commission can file a complaint
- 11 on its own motion if it's -- if it does not concur with the
- 12 Staff that the delay was excusable.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. Thank you.
- 14 Mr. Mills or Mr. Fischer, anything you want to put
- 15 on the record?
- 16 MR. FISCHER: No, Your Honor. That seems like a
- 17 good way to handle it at this time, to -- to the Company.
- 18 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. Mr. Mills?
- 19 MR. MILLS: I -- I've got nothing to add to the
- 20 record. Thank you.
- 21 JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. Well, as you're well
- 22 aware, the Commission rule on this, 242.116(1), allows Staff
- 23 or any other Complainant to dismiss their complaint at any
- 24 time before evidence has been offered.
- 25 And without any further order from the Commission,

- 1 there's not been any evidence offered in this case. So Staff
- 2 has dismissed its complaint. At this point the -- the case
- 3 is -- the complaint is dismissed.
- 4 I will issue an order in -- or excuse me -- a
- 5 notice in the case just acknowledging the filing of that
- 6 dismissal and closing the case.
- 7 MR. SCHWARZ: And if -- you know, I -- I would
- 8 appreciate it if you would communicate to either individual
- 9 Commissioners or the Commission that Staff would be available
- 10 at their convenience to provide --
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Sure.
- 12 MR. SCHWARZ: -- you know, some detail on -- on
- 13 things.
- 14 JUDGE WOODRUFF: And before we got on to the
- 15 record, you mentioned the names of Warren Wood, Dave Summer
- 16 were --
- 17 MR. SCHWARZ: Yes.
- 18 JUDGE WOODRUFF: -- the ones that had looked into
- 19 this?
- MR. SCHWARZ: Yes.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. Anything further?
- (NO RESPONSE.)
- 23 JUDGE WOODRUFF: With that then, this prehearing is
- 24 adjourned, and we'll go off the record.
- 25 WHEREUPON, the on-the-record portion of the

1 prehearing conference was concluded.
