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1 PROCEEDINGS
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- 2 JUDGE JORDAN: The Commission calls the
- 3 case that is listed under File Number GC-2010-0225
- 4 which is called Holley versus AmerenUE. I'm Daniel
- 5 Jordan. I'm the regulatory law judge assigned to
- 6 this case. We'll start with entries of appearance
- 7 and note client representatives. We'll start with
- 8 the Complainant. And I don't see anyone in this room
- 9 who looks like the Complainant. Is Frances or John
- 10 Holley on the line right now?
- 11 (NO RESPONSE.)
- 12 JUDGE JORDAN: I'm not hearing anything,
- 13 and I've been out in the lobby of this building to
- 14 see if anyone is looking for this room, and I haven't
- 15 seen anyone, so the Holleys are absent. Let's go
- 16 next to AmerenUE, please.
- 17 MS. GIBONEY: This is Sarah Giboney,
- 18 Smith Lewis, Columbia, Missouri for AmerenUE.
- 19 MS. TATRO: And Wendy Tatro, 1901
- 20 Chouteau Avenue, St. Louis, Missouri 63103, for
- 21 AmerenUE.
- JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you. And do you
- 23 have representatives of your clients here today also?
- MS. TATRO: We do not.
- 25 MS. HART: Kathy Hart, and I am at 101

- 1 Madison, Jefferson City, AmerenUE.
- 2 JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you. Anyone else
- 3 for AmerenUE?
- 4 (NO RESPONSE.)
- 5 JUDGE JORDAN: Okay. Not hearing
- 6 anyone, so we'll go next to Staff.
- 7 MR. RITCHIE: Appearing for the Staff of
- 8 the Public Service Commission, Sam Ritchie, P.O. Box
- 9 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.
- 10 JUDGE JORDAN: Mr. Ritchie, you have
- 11 some representatives, your client, today also, do you
- 12 not?
- MR. RITCHIE: I do. From the Consumer
- 14 Services Department I have Mary Duncan and Gay Fred.
- JUDGE JORDAN: And also technically the
- 16 Office of Public Counsel is a party to this action,
- 17 so I'll ask if there's anyone on the line
- 18 representing Office of Public Counsel?
- 19 (NO RESPONSE.)
- JUDGE JORDAN: And I'm not hearing
- 21 anything and I don't see anyone in this room who is
- 22 from the Office of Public Counsel, so there we are.
- Well, part of the purpose of this
- 24 proceeding was to help -- to explain to the
- 25 Complainants how the procedure in a complaint action

- 1 goes, but since they're absent, there wouldn't be a
- 2 whole lot of purpose for that, even more so, since we
- 3 have experienced counsel in this case who probably
- 4 don't really need my help with that kind of
- 5 explanation.
- 6 I will ask one thing, though, which is
- 7 something I'd hoped to straighten out in this
- 8 proceeding. We had one John W. Holley filing this
- 9 action on behalf of Frances Ann Holley, and there are
- 10 indications in the file that they are brother and
- 11 sister, that he has power of attorney for her, so
- 12 I'll start with AmerenUE and ask them whether they
- 13 can tell me who is liable on the account, who really
- 14 is the Complainant here.
- MS. HART: Well, I can tell you the name
- 16 that is under the account is under Frances Holley.
- 17 JUDGE JORDAN: Okay. As far as you can
- 18 tell, does John Holley have any liability on this
- 19 bill, on this account?
- 20 MS. HART: I don't know that his name is
- 21 anywhere on that.
- 22 JUDGE JORDAN: Okay. All right. Does
- 23 Staff have any reason to believe that the matter is
- 24 otherwise then as described here.
- 25 MS. DUNCAN: Other than the billing as

- 1 it's mailed out is mailed out to her in care of him,
- 2 so they are mutually addressed on the billing.
- JUDGE JORDAN: Okay. AmerenUE, does
- 4 that sound like what your records reflect? Is it
- 5 mailed to one person in care of another?
- 6 MS. HART: I can look at that.
- 7 JUDGE JORDAN: Please do. As to that, I
- 8 don't know that it would really make a difference.
- 9 MS. HART: It is mailed to John Holley
- 10 at a different address, but we have several -- you
- 11 know, a lot of accounts that do that, people have
- 12 those mailed to others, but we really will look to
- 13 Frances Holley for the bill to be paid.
- MR. RITCHIE: We do have copies of bills
- 15 with both names.
- 16 JUDGE JORDAN: Okay. But that sounds
- 17 more like a mailing arrangement than a payment,
- 18 necessarily a liability arrangement.
- MS. DUNCAN: We don't have paper
- 20 documentation, but we do have Mr. Holley's verbal
- 21 report that he has power of attorney for his sister,
- 22 that she is disabled.
- JUDGE JORDAN: Okay. But as far as
- 24 AmerenUE knows, they're just sending the bills to him
- 25 for payment for -- for payment, but he's not the one

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    using the service and he's not the one liable for
    payment; is that correct?
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                  MS. HART: That is correct.
                  JUDGE JORDAN: Okay. All right. Well,
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    I think that's about as much clarification as we can
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    get on that issue. I think that's about all we can
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    do without the Complainants here. But I do
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    appreciate your time and I do appreciate your
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    assistance with straightening out that issue.
                  So unless somebody has something else,
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    we can go off the record. Does anybody else have
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    anything?
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                  MS. TATRO: No.
                  MR. RITCHIE: Nothing from Staff.
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                  JUDGE JORDAN: Okay. Well, thank you
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    very much for your time and thank you for your
    assistance in figuring out who the Complainant really
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    is here. And with that, I will adjourn this
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    prehearing conference and we'll go off the record.
