On April 16, 2009, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel the certificates of convenience and necessity of Missouri Gas Company, LLC and Missouri Pipeline Company, LLC, as well as the associated tariffs.

On June 24, 2009, Staff filed a withdrawal of its April 16 Motion as litigation is pending in several courts, including an extraordinary writ filed in the Supreme Court of Missouri in Case No. SC90166. Staff indicated they will again request cancellation after such pending litigation is resolved.
