ORDER DIRECTING AQUILA TO RESPOND

On March 30, 2006, the Commission granted Aquila, Inc., a variance from the meter testing requirements of Commission rule 4 CSR 240-10.030(19). That order directed Aquila to file tariff sheets referencing the granted variance by April 19. Aquila has not yet filed such a tariff. The Commission will direct Aquila to either file the tariff, or explain why the tariff should not be filed as ordered.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Aquila, Inc., shall file a tariff no later than May 11, 2006, referencing the meter testing variance previously granted by the Commission.
2. If Aquila, Inc., is unable to file such tariff by May 11, 2006, it shall file a pleading by that date explaining why such tariff cannot be filed.

3. This order shall become effective on April 27, 2006.
