On February 17, 2006, Aquila, Inc., filed an application for a variance from the meter testing requirements of Commission rule 4 CSR 240-10.030(19). The Commission will need to have a recommendation from its Staff before acting on the application.

So that it may be aware of progress in this case, the Commission will direct its Staff to file a pleading indicating when it will be able to file a recommendation.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall, no later than March 13, 2006, file a pleading advising the Commission when Staff will be able to file its recommendation regarding Aquila, Inc.'s application.
