## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DEADLINES FOR INTERVENTION APPLICATIONS AND STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

On June 25, 2020, Spire Missouri Inc. applied for a depreciation authority order establishing a new annual deprecation rate for smart meter devices. Spire requests a decision by no later than September 30, 2020. Spire also requests waiver of the Commission's 60-day notice requirement under 20 CSR 4240-4.017.

The Commission will direct notice be given and set a deadline for intervention applications. The Commission will also direct Staff to file a recommendation.

- 3. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall provide notice of Spire's application to members of the General Assembly representing residents in Spire's service territory.

- 4. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall provide notice of Spire's application to news media serving residents of Spire's service territory.
- 5. Applications for intervention shall be filed no later than July 10, 2020. Any such filing shall be submitted through the Commission's electronic filing and information system or delivered to:

- 6. No later than July 27, 2020, the Commission's Staff shall file either a recommendation regarding Spire's application or a status report indicating when it expects to file a recommendation.
