## ORDER DIRECTING EXPEDITED STAFF RECOMMENDATION AND SETTING TIME FOR ANY RESPONSES TO TARIFF FILING

On October 28, 2021, the Commission issued an order approving Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire's COVID-19 Residential Assistance Program tariff sheets for its Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West operations. That program was due to end on March 31, 2021. On March 24, 2021, the Commission approved tariff sheets to extend that program an additional two months to May 31, 2021.

On May 24, 2021, Spire submitted tariff sheets and a motion for expedited treatment to further extend the COVID-19 Residential Assistance Program by one month. The tariff sheets have an effective date of June 23, 2021, but Spire asks that the Commission approve the tariff sheets to be effective by June 1, 2021, so that there is no gap in the COVID-19 Residential Assistance Program.

In consideration of the requested effective date of the tariff sheets, the Commission will direct the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission to file a recommendation on an expedited schedule. The Commission will also establish a deadline for any other entity to file a response to the tariffs.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. No later than 3:30 p.m. on May 25, 2021, the Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation with regard to the revised tariff sheets filed by Spire, Tariff Nos. YG-2021-0202 and YG-2021-0203, and Spire's request for expedited treatment.
2. Any other person or entity wishing to comment on Spire's tariff revision or motion for expedited treatment shall file a response no later than 3:30 p.m. on May 25, 2021.
3. This order is effective when issued.
