## ORDER SCHEDULING ON-THE-RECORD PRESENTATION

On March 8, 2007, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, the Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, the Missouri School Boards' Association, and the Missouri Retailers Association filed a stipulation and agreement to resolve all pending issues in this case.
