On December 14, 2009,¹ the Office of the Public Counsel (hereafter "OPC) filed a Motion for Extension of Time. Post-hearing briefs are due today, December 15. OPC asks for an extension of time until December 18 for the parties to file their briefs. OPC further asks for an extension of time until January 5, 2010, for the parties to file their reply and true-up briefs.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows ten days to respond to motions. However, because OPC's request for relief involves a time period before the ten-day limit, and because OPC indicates no party objects, the Commission will rule on the motion immediately.

The Commission finds OPC's motion reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Motion for Extension of Time is granted.
- 2. Initial post-hearing briefs shall be filed no later than December 18, 2009.
- 3. Reply briefs and true-up briefs shall be filed no later than January 5, 2010.
