ORDER APPROVING INTERIM RATES

Issue Date: October 27, 2010

Effective Date: November 1, 2010

On October 15, 2010, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed revised tariff sheets with a proposed effective date of November 1, 2010. The purpose of the tariff sheets is to modify Ameren's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors for its service areas. The proposed changes are as follows:

1. For the area served by Panhandle Eastern Pipe Line Company (PEPL), including the cities of Columbia, Jefferson City, Mexico, and Wentzville; and excluding the Rolla Service Area, the PGA rate filed by Ameren will increase to \$0.7300 per hundred cubic feet ("Ccf") from the current PGA rate of \$0.7100. This represents an increase of \$0.0200 per Ccf.
2. For the area served by Texas Eastern Transmission Corporation (TETCO), including the city of Cape Girardeau, the PGA rate filed by Ameren will increase to \$0.7300 from the current PGA rate of \$0.7100 per Ccf. This represents an increase of \$0.0200 per Ccf.
3. For the area served by Natural Gas Pipeline Company of America (NGPL), including the community of Marble Hill, the PGA rate filed by Ameren will increase to \$0.7300 from the current PGA rate of \$0.7100 per Ccf. This represents an increase of \$0.0200 per Ccf.
4. For the Rolla Service Area, including the cities of Rolla and Owensville, the effect of these changes will decrease the PGA rate to \$0.8400 per Ccf from the current PGA rate of \$0.8700. This represents a decrease of \$.0300 per Ccf.

The Commission established filing deadlines of October 22, 2010, for its Staff's recommendation and October 26, 2010, for any other responses to Ameren's tariff or to

Staff's recommendation. Staff filed its recommendation on October 22, 2010. No other responses were filed.

Staff states that Ameren's proposed PGA factor changes were calculated in conformity with its PGA clause. Staff further states that Ameren's PGA clause allows for ten business days' notice for filings reflecting PGA changes, and that good cause exists to approve the proposed tariff sheets on less than 30 days' notice. Staff recommends that the Commission approve the tariff sheets to become effective on November 1, 2010, on an interim basis, subject to refund, pending final Commission decisions in this case and in Ameren's other Actual Cost Adjustment cases, which are File Nos. GR-2009-0337 and GR-2008-0366.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff sheets and Staff's Recommendation. The Commission finds that the tariff sheets conform to Ameren's Commission-approved PGA clause and are, therefore, reasonable. After considering Staff's recommendation, and for good cause shown pursuant to Section 393.140(11), RSMo 2000, the Commission concludes that the proposed tariff sheets should be approved to become effective on and after the requested effective date of November 1, on an interim basis, subject to refund.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following tariff sheets filed by Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, designated Tariff No. YG-2011-0205, are approved on an interim basis, subject to refund, pending final Commission decisions in File Nos. GR-2010-0180, GR-2009-0337, and GR-2008-0366, for service rendered on and after November 1, 2010.
