

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Missouri Division of Energy Application to Intervene* (“motion”).<sup>1</sup> The Missouri School Boards’ Association filed the motion on January 27, 2014. The Commission received no response to the motion within the time prescribed by regulation.<sup>2</sup> The motion alleges facts supporting the intervention on a timely motion.<sup>3</sup> Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

- 1. The *Missouri Division of Energy Application to Intervene* is granted.
- 2. This order is effective immediately on issuance.
