ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTIONS

On February 6, 2014¹, Liberty Energy (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp., d/b/a Liberty Utilities ("Liberty") filed the above-styled tariff and rate case. The Commission gave notice to the public on February 7. The Missouri Division of Energy ("DE") and Noranda Aluminum, Inc., ("Noranda") filed timely intervention requests.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to motions. No party objected to the applications. Therefore, the Commission will take them up unopposed.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4) allows the Commission to grant intervention to a person who has an interest different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would serve the public interest. Upon review of the unopposed applications, the Commission finds that DE and Noranda meet the standard in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4). Therefore, the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.
