ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO WITHDRAW AS COUNSEL

On June 9, 2021, Amy L. Baird, Richard A. Howell, and Luke Gilman of Jackson Walker L.L.P. filed a motion asking leave to withdraw as counsel for the Complainant, Symmetry Energy Solutions, LLC (Symmetry).¹ The motion explains that the Healy Law Offices will continue to represent Symmetry. The motion also represents that Symmetry has consented to the withdrawal of counsel.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.040(6) provides that an attorney who has entered an appearance on behalf of a party may withdraw from that representation only by leave of the Commission. Since Symmetry will continue to be represented by other counsel, the Commission will grant the requested leave to withdraw.
