## **STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION**

COMES NOW Staff of the Public Service Commission of Missouri, and for its recommendation states:

- 1. On May 10, 2005, Laclede Gas Company filed its application for a variance from certain portions of its tariff concerning meter testing. Laclede stated that the variance would help its program to install automated meter reading equipment throughout its service area.
- 2. The variance would permit Laclede to systematically replace meters that cannot be fitted with AMR devices, typically older meters. For a fuller description, see the Staff Memorandum attached as Attachment A.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission grant Laclede the variance, and order Laclede to note in its tariff both this variance and the variance granted in Case No. GO-95-320.
