And I'll let you 11 12 discuss that also. And if -- if they can be 13 dismissed, let me know. If there's going to be an issue on that, let me know also at the time 14 you file the procedural schedule. 15 16 Any matters anyone wants to bring up while we're on the record? 17 MR. FINNEGAN: I have one question 18 just to -- what was the prehearing schedule? 19 20 By when? JUDGE WOODRUFF: By one week from 21 22 today, which would be the 23rd. 23 MR. FINNEGAN: Okay. Thank you. 24 JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. Well, 25 hearing nothing that needs to be on the record,
