**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO EXTEND TARIFF FILING DATE**

On March 24, 2012, the Commission issued an Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement. That order required Liberty Energy (Midstates) Corp. (“Liberty”) to file a compliance tariff no later than April 23.

On April 23, Liberty filed a Motion to Extend Tariff Filing Date. Liberty explains that the closing between Liberty and Atmos Energy Corporation has not yet occurred. Thus, Liberty asks the Commission to extend Liberty’s deadline to file tariffs to after the closing of the transaction approved by the Commission. Liberty advises that no party objects to the motion.

The Commission finds the motion reasonable, and will grant it.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Motion to Extend Tariff Filing Date is granted.
2. Liberty Energy (Midstates) Corp. shall file compliance tariffs after the closing date of its transaction with Atmos Energy Corporation.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
