On January 3, 2007, Missouri Gas Energy and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a Partial Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement Concerning Depreciation. As stated by the parties to the agreement, it is their understanding that neither the Office of the Public Counsel nor Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation opposes the agreement.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.115(2)(B) requires that objections to this nonunanimous stipulation and agreement be filed within seven days. This would require that parties file their objections by midnight on January 10. Because evidence on depreciation is to be presented on January 11, the Commission will shorten the time for objections to the agreement.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party opposing the Partial Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement concerning depreciation, submitted by Missouri Gas Energy and the Staff of the Commission, shall file its objection no later than 12:00 p.m. on January 10, 2007.

2. This order shall become effective on January 3, 2007.
