## **ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO ATMOS' MOTION TO QUASH SUBPOENA**

On March 8, 2011, Atmos Energy Corporation filed a motion asking the Commission to quash a subpoena duces tecum that the Commission's Staff served on Mike Walker, an Atmos employee. The subpoena directs Walker to appear at the hearing before the Commission on March 23 and to produce multiple documents. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.180(15) allows ten days in which to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. The Commission must resolve this disagreement before the start of the hearing and for that reason will shorten the time for response.

### **THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any party wishing to respond to the Motion for Protective Order of Atmos Energy Corporation to Quash Hearing Subpoena shall do so no later than 1:00 p.m. on March 11, 2011.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
