LACLEDE GAS COMPANY'S MOTION TO FILE POST-HEARING EXHIBIT

)

COMES NOW Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede" or "Company"), pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.130(17), and in support of its Motion to File Post-Hearing Exhibit, states as follows.

- 1. Pursuant to an Order Scheduling Evidentiary Hearing and Notice of Invitation issued in this case on November 20, 2003, the Commission held an expedited hearing on December 5, 2003. The limited purpose of the hearing was to provide the Commissioners with an opportunity to ask questions regarding Laclede's pending application to establish a 10,000 foot per year replacement schedule for its unprotected steel main program and Staff's recommendations regarding continuation of the Company's copper service line replacement program.
- 2. During the December 5 hearing, in response to questions from the Commission, Laclede witness Craig Hoeferlin provided testimony on Laclede's estimated expenditures between 1998 and 2004 on its major safety replacement programs. (Tr. 173-74, 177-83). Upon review of that testimony, Laclede can confirm all of the figures provided by Mr. Hoeferlin, except for the annual expenditures on the unprotected steel main program. In its haste to provide a quick breakdown of the costs for each of these

major safety programs, Laclede inadvertently used an incorrect average cost per foot to calculate what portion of these overall expenditures were associated with its unprotected steel main program. The attached exhibit corrects for this inaccuracy and shows the proper level of annual expenditures related to the Company's unprotected steel main replacement program.

- 3. Laclede would further note that the figures it provided on unprotected steel replacement expenditures on December 5, and that it provides in corrected form in the attached Exhibit, cover only expenditures associated with categories 3 through 6 in Commission Rule 40.030(15)(E). These figures do not include costs incurred to replace unprotected steel main in categories 1 and 2 of Rule 40.030(15)(E), since Laclede has completed replacements in that category. However, Laclede would note that such expenditures averaged approximately \$150,000 each year.
- 4. Laclede seeks to file the attached post-hearing exhibit in order to provide the Commission with a more accurate calculation of the amounts expended by Laclede on its unprotected steel main program. Because replacement of unprotected steel main is the specific subject matter of this case, it is important that this information be as accurate as possible.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Laclede Gas Company respectfully requests that the Commission accept the post-hearing exhibit attached hereto and designated as Exhibit 3/Exhibit 3P in this case.
