JUDGE WOODRUFF: Well, my watch shows it's ten o'clock so we'll go ahead and get started. We're here for a procedural conference in File Nos. GO-2019-0115 and GO-2019-0116, and this is concerning the partial rehearing that the Commission has ordered and I'll be the judge in this case. Now this is Judge Woodruff, if you didn't recognize my voice.

MR. BERLIN: Appearing on behalf of the staff of the Commission are Bob Berlin and Ron Irving at the Commission's office in Jefferson City. The court reporter has our contact information.

MR. CLIZER: Appearing on behalf of public counsel, John Clizer and Lera Shemwell, and I will supply our information with the court reporter.

JUDGE WOODRUFF: And I believe that's all the parties in this case. The Commission set this up for

the purpose of establishing a procedural schedule to deal with a partial rehearing that it had ordered. The Commission's order back on July 25 specified what they wanted which was filings of direct testimony by Spire and staff and optionally by public counsel regarding the methodology and calculations used to determine the amount of property tax.

I'm assuming that if the parties can agree upon what numbers are actually there and don't even need a procedural schedule the Commission would accept that as well. But if we need to have a hearing, this is the time to try and come up with a schedule to do that.

Any questions or any matters while we're on the record? Mr. Clizer?

MR. CLIZER: I was just going to say, and the other parties can correct me if they think this is wrong, but I believe that we are actually very close to a settlement at this point. I believe that we have an agreement in principle as to the numbers and that we're just working on a few minor tweaks and we were actually hoping to use this opportunity to kind of have a technical settlement conference. I don't think that would need to be on the record, of course. That being the case, I'm not sure that we need a strict procedural schedule again unless one of the other parties would
