To whom it may concern:

I am writing this letter as a formal complaint. It seems that La Clede Gas has practiced some questionable billing methods. I live in an apartment that is 568 sq. feet of living sq. space. This is rather small. There are 8 units in the 2 buildings which all have the same sq. footage. The gas co. has meters inside and outside of the buildings which are read I don't know how. The fact is that there are a wide variance in billing from unit to unit. My bill is \$228, for the month of February My neighbors received bills that are quite a lot less. With the exception of the lady that lives behind me who has her meter at the same location as mine. Her bill for the month of February was \$204. I have always paid my bills but this truly unfair and unwarrented.

In Sept. of last year I called LaClede Gas to be put on the Cold Weather Rule. This would allow distribution of the charges over a period of time and according to the Gas Co. some financial help. Up to that time my bill was current. I was told at that time that a meter reading was necessary in order to adjust my bill and qualify for the Cold Weather Rule. Someone was supposed to come read the meter no-one ever did. So I called the Gas co. and was told to take the meter reading myself I am visually impaired and cannot read the numbers. So a neighbor Gary Gendron read the meter and gave to the girl over the phone. This led to my receiving a bill of \$800.00 in November. I called and told them that I cannot pay that amount since I am on a fixed income. They suggested that I pay \$200.00 a month which I cannot pay since disability only goes so far. I have still sent them at least \$70,00 a month thru all of this. After talking to several people at the company I was finally referred to Mr. John Lair. He is Customer relation supervisor and can be reached at (314) 342-0500 ext 603. He admits that there was a malfunctioning reading device. My bill is currently over \$1000.00. For the month of January my bill was \$134.00. January was much colder than it was in Februay. Again I live in a small apartment that is 568 square feet of living space. My beliefe is that the meter is still not functioning. The Gas co. also wants me to go to charitable agency's to get money to give them. I feel that money is for poor people to feed their children and not to pay companies who make mistakes and then want other people to pay for their mistakes. I have voiced my concerns to a John Lair who is manager customer relations and who's phone is (314) 342-0500 ext. 603. They persist they have made no mistakes.

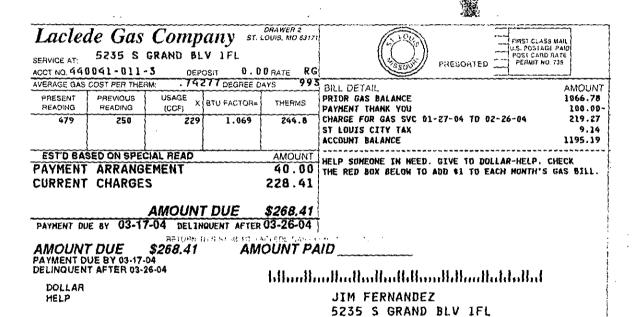
