
NOTICE OF VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL



1. After voluntary mediation between Mr. Eckhoff and MGE at the Alternative Dispute Resolution Center at the University of Missouri-Columbia School of Law, Mr. Eckhoff and MGE have agreed to a satisfaction of this matter which resolves this Complaint.
2. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) states that a complaint may be voluntarily dismissed "at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered, by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission and serving a copy on all parties."
