- JUDGE LANE: Good morning, ladies and
- 3 gentlemen. It's about 9:24 on Monday, July the 30th,
- 4 2007, and we're here today for the second prehearing
- 5 conference in Case No. GC-2007-0382. That's Clyde
- 6 Bradford vs. Laclede Gas Company. And my name is Benjamin
- 7 Lane. I'm the Regulatory Law Judge assigned to this case.
- 8 The Commission by Order dated July 12th of
- 9 this year set this second prehearing conference. And
- 10 Mr. Bradford, I know you part-- everyone on the line
- 11 today, and we'll take appearances in just a moment,
- 12 appeared at the first prehearing conference.
- So I'm not going to go through some of the
- 14 details that I did last time as to the purposes of this
- 15 and the types of things that can be achieved in a
- 16 prehearing conference because we already made -- already
- 17 indicated that last time. And I think everyone involved
- 18 knows what work we have left to do and to take this
- 19 opportunity to do it.
- MR. BRADFORD: Okay.
- JUDGE LANE: So before we proceed any
- 22 further, I know that you filed written entries of
- 23 appearance, but before we proceed any further, if we could
- 24 go ahead and take oral entries of appearance. Let's start
- 25 with Mr. Bradford now. Mr. Bradford, you're representing

- 1 yourself in this matter; is that correct?
- MR. BRADFORD: Yes. At this time, yes.
- 3 JUDGE LANE: All right. For the Staff of
- 4 the Commission?
- 5 MR. BERLIN: Robert S. Berlin and Sarah
- 6 Kliethermes appearing on behalf of the Staff of the
- 7 Missouri Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 360,
- 8 Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.
- 9 JUDGE LANE: Thank you very much.
- 10 Appearing for Laclede Gas?
- 11 MR. ZUCKER: Rick Zucker, Z-u-c-k-e-r,
- 12 appearing for Laclede Gas Company, 720 Olive Street,
- 13 St. Louis, Missouri 63101.
- 14 JUDGE LANE: Thank you, Mr. Zucker. And
- 15 appearing for the Office of Public Counsel?
- MR. POSTON: Thank you. Marc Poston
- 17 appearing for the Office of the Public Counsel and the
- 18 public, P.O. Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.
- JUDGE LANE: Mr. Poston, thank you.
- 20 MR. BERLIN: And, Judge, I'd like to also
- 21 mention for the record that the Staff also has present Gay
- 22 Fred, the customer service manager, and Marilyn Doerhoff,
- 23 the customer service representative who have been working
- 24 on this case.
- 25 MR. BERLIN: Thank you very much. I very

- 1 much appreciate their presence today because you've got
- 2 two people who are very knowledgeable about this case that
- 3 have followed it in its earlier stages. And,
- 4 Mr. Bradford, they are here, as is everyone, to assist in
- 5 attempting to resolve this case if that's going to be
- 6 possible, and they have information, and I know you've
- 7 exchanged additional information.
- 8 Since this is the second prehearing
- 9 conference, as I mentioned right before -- as I mentioned
- 10 earlier, I probably won't be here too awfully long. I
- 11 think everyone knows why we're here and what we're
- 12 attempting to accomplish, and we have individuals here who
- 13 are knowledgeable about this case.
- 14 And this provides -- the reason the
- 15 Commission granted this second prehearing conference is
- 16 that after we had the first one back on June the 19th,
- 17 there was additional information that was determined after
- 18 that first prehearing conference that some additional
- 19 information needed to be gathered. And I think,
- 20 Mr. Bradford, you had indicated at that time that that
- 21 would be helpful to have the sides get some more
- 22 information bearing on your complaint, and so -- regarding
- 23 your billing records.
- 24 So the Commission granted this second
- 25 prehearing conference to give the parties another

- 1 opportunity to determine settlement possibilities in this
- 2 matter or, in the alternative, to develop a procedural
- 3 schedule, because the Commission's Order setting this
- 4 second prehearing conference also required the parties to
- 5 jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule no
- 6 later than August the 6th, which is not too far away.
- 7 So, Mr. Bradford, do you understand what
- 8 we're here to do -- or what we're here to do today?
- 9 MR. BRADFORD: Yes, I understand.
- 10 JUDGE LANE: And this gives you an
- 11 opportunity. Do you understand why we're here today?
- MR. BRADFORD: Yes, I do.
- JUDGE LANE: Thank you very much. And I
- 14 know, Mr. Zucker, that you do and Staff and OPC as well.
- 15 So I want to thank the parties for their indulgence for
- 16 the brief delay that we had this morning getting all
- 17 hooked up, but we have finally made it.
- 18 And unless there are any other questions or
- 19 concerns, I'm going to leave the room. We're going to
- 20 close the on-the-record portion of this prehearing
- 21 conference. I'm going to allow you, the parties, to
- 22 discuss this matter amongst yourself. Open, frank
- 23 discussion is what we're looking for, compromise if it's
- 24 possible, if it's reasonable. That's always -- that's
- 25 always favored.

1	Any questions of me before we close the
2	on-the-record portion and I leave?
3	MR. BRADFORD: No.
4	JUDGE LANE: Hearing none, thank you very
5	much again, and have a good prehearing, and you will be
6	hearing from me well, I imagine I'll be hearing from
7	the parties later about the about what transpired at
8	this and possibly either a procedural schedule or other
9	additional actions that might be appropriate.
10	Thank you very much. We're off the record
11	WHEREUPON, the recorded portion of the
12	prehearing conference was concluded.
