**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE,  
SETTING DATE FOR INTERVENTION,  
AND DIRECTING RESPONSES TO APPLICATION**

On July 9, 2013, Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. filed an application seeking a waiver of Commission rule 4 CSR 240-3.235, which requires companies to submit a depreciation study, database and property unit catalog with requests for rate increases.

In its application, Summit states that it intends to request a rate increase around January 2014.

Because Summit's application is relevant to its anticipated request for a rate increase, the Commission will afford an opportunity for intervention from those who might seek to intervene in the company's rate case. The Commission points out that lack of participation in this docket will not preclude intervention in the company's anticipated rate case.

The Commission will also direct that the Staff of the Commission file a response to Summit's application and will set a time for responses from the Office of the Public Counsel.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commission of each county within Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc.'s service areas, and upon the corresponding governing body for cities not within a county.

2. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc.'s service area and to the news media serving therein.

3. Applications to intervene shall be filed no later than August 9, 2013, with:

4. Requests to intervene shall include a statement of position regarding the application for waiver.

5. The Staff of the Commission shall file a response to Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc.'s application no later than August 13, 2013.

6. The Office of the Public Counsel may file a response to Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc.'s application no later than August 13, 2013.

7. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
