On March 25, 2021, Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire filed a motion to modify the effective date of the Commission’s March 3, 2021 *Order Extending Temporary Waiver and Directing Written Notice*. The Commission’s order is effective May 2, 2021, to fulfill the requirement for 60 days’ written notice to the U.S. Secretary of Transportation before the effective date of a state commission order approving a waiver of a requirement under federal gas safety regulations.

On March 25, 2021, the Staff of the Commission filed a notice and attached a letter from the Department of Transportation’s Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, stating no objection to the waiver extension granted by the Commission. Spire requests the effective date of the order be modified to April 1, 2021. Spire’s motion requests expedited treatment.

The Commission will direct Staff to file a recommendation by no later than 8:30 a.m. March 30, 2021.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than 8:30 a.m. March 30, 2021, Staff shall file a recommendation on Spire’s request.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
