## ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR RESPONSE TO MOTION TO SHORTEN DATA REQUEST TIME LIMITS

Issue Date: October 22, 2020 Effective Date: October 22, 2020

On October 16, 2020, Spire filed a motion to modify the Commission's June 11, 2020 *Order Approving Application for Temporary Waiver and Directing Written Notice*. Spire requests elimination or extension of the requirement that inspections of noncompliant facilities be completed no later than one year after each facility's "delinquent date." Spire also requests the deadline under the order be extended to March 31, 2021. Spire's motion requests expedited treatment.

The Commission ordered the Staff of the Commission to file a recommendation regarding Spire's request or a status report stating when it will be able to file such a recommendation.

On October 22, 2020, Staff filed a status report stating that it is consulting with the Pipeline Hazardous Materials Safety Administration and expects to be able to file a recommendation by no later than November 20, 2020. Staff's report is accompanied by a motion to shorten data request time periods for any additional data requests in this case. Specifically, Staff requests the Commission shorten the response time to five business days and shorten the period to object or seek extension to two business days.

To facilitate expedited review of Spire's motion, the Commission will establish a deadline for any objection or other response to Staff's motion to shorten data request time limits.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Any objection to Staff's motion to shorten data request time limits in this case shall be filed no later than October 27, 2020.
  - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
