ENTRY OF APPEARANCE

COME NOW Stuart W. Conrad and David L. Woodsmall of Finnegan, Conrad & Peterson, L.C. and hereby enter their appearance herein on behalf of Praxair, Inc ("Praxair").

On September 5, 2008, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") submitted to the Commission proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for electrical service provided by KCPL in its Missouri service area.

The Commission issued an Order Directing Filing and Directing Notice in this case on September 12, 2008. In that Order, the Commission established an intervention deadline but also provided that all non-KCPL signatory parties to the stipulation approved in Commission Case No. EO-2005-0329 were being made parties. Further, in Case No. EO-2005-0329, the Commission-approved stipulation provided that all non-KCPL signatories could intervene as a matter of right in this proceeding. Praxair was a party to that case and a signatory to the stipulation. Therefore, counsel for Praxair is filing this Entry of Appearance in

lieu of a notice or motion to intervene pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075.
